

QUEENSLAND IS BANNING PLASTIC BAGS

MAKE SURE YOU'RE READY

Single-use, lightweight plastic bags will be banned in Queensland from July 1, 2018. The Queensland State Government is adopting similar laws to other Australian states, but with one key difference - degradable and compostable versions of plastic bags will also be banned. **Who will it affect?**

- Supermarkets
- Convenience stores
- Take-away food stores
- Pharmacies
- Liquor stores
- Other retail businesses

Retailers will be forbidden from supplying plastic bags, with penalties applying after July 1, 2018. The National Retailer's Association recommends that retailers start planning and considering alternative options now. For all the facts head to www.qldbagan.com.au

WHAT IS BEING BANNED?



Lightweight plastic bags, less than 35 microns thick, with handles ('singlet' bags), including those deemed as biodegradable, degradable or compostable.



WHAT IS ALLOWED?

Paper Bags

Barrier bags (typically fruit and vegetable and deli-style bags without handles)

Woven or fabric bags (like 'green' bags)

Heavier-weight plastic bags (like those used by department stores)

Bags that are integral to a product's packaging (such as a bread bag)

Kitchen tidy bags.



MAKE THE MOVE TO PAPER, JUST LIKE BRUCE!
